



Apprenticeships

What is it – Apprenticeships are where you learn and earn at the same time. You will already be working for a local business, earning a wage and gaining practical skills.

Entry Requirements – Whatever your employer has asked for when you applied for the job. Some employers do not require qualifications and want practical skills, while others require 4 or 5 GCSE' at grades 9 – 5 including English, maths and science.

What Level - Level 2 and 3

How long – A minimum of 1 year

How many subjects – 1 subject in a work based area such as catering, motor vehicle, hairdressing, Beauty, construction, media, hospitality and many more

How will I learn – You will probably attend College for 1 or 2 days day a week and work at your place of work for the other 4 days. You will study for your qualification from a mixture of workshops, work based assessments, e-learning and taught courses.

Progression – After completing Level 3 qualification you will be a fully qualified trade's person and gain employment with a Company, become self-employed and start your own business or progress further and go onto university.
