



HEALTH, SAFETY AND SECURITY REGULATIONS

For reasons of Health and Safety and Hygiene:-

- No chewing gum.
- No smoking materials or illegal substances.
- No piercings other than one piercing in each ear.
- No solvent based products including tip-pex and aerosols.
- No laser pens.
- No alcohol.
- Food and drink can only be consumed inside designated eating areas.
- Dining area tables are for food; they are not seats.
- Medicines and prescription drugs should be deposited with the Student Services reception and relevant forms completed.
- No cycling within school grounds and cyclists must leave by the nearest gate.
- Fire doors must be fully operable at all times, and must not be blocked.
- Do not attempt to operate windows or blinds, or sit on window sills.
- Ball games should only be played in the designated outside areas.
- No knives or items that could be classified as an offensive weapon that could cause injury or harm. Including replica weapons or articles deemed offensive or dangerous.*
- Any cycles, skateboards or micro scooters must be stored in the cycle shed at the owners risk. They should not be used or carried around the school site.

For reasons of safety keep away from out of bounds areas including:-

- Roofs.
- Car parks.
- Labs/workshops and classrooms unless a teacher is present.
- Shrubberies and unknown areas.

AREAS OUT OF SIGHT ARE OUT OF BOUNDS. STUDENTS MUST NOT LEAVE THE SCHOOL SITE WITHOUT PERMISSION.

For reasons of security:-

- The area at the front of the school is not to be used by students at break or lunch.
- Do not bring valuable personal property or large amounts of cash to school.
- Use lockers carefully.
- Remain outside the buildings until 8.10 a.m. unless attending breakfast club in the restaurant, in Student Services, the sandwich room or the prefects' room.

We discourage you from bringing valuable items such as mobile phones and MP3 players into school as we cannot and will not be responsible for them.

- **Offensive weapons are defined in the Prevention of Crime Act 1953 as “any article made or adapted for causing injury to the person; or intended by the person having it with him/her for such use by him/her”.**
